Is the Academic Foundation Year right for me?

The Academic Foundation Year (AFY) is a novel approach to education. The structure of the AFY is based on an instructional model called the flipped classroom, which is a type of blended learning that reverses the traditional learning environment. Students will develop sound study habits and have access to career counseling as well as developing their language skills.



The Academic Foundation Year is comprised of four learning tracks: the coaching and counseling program, an academic core program, language skills program, and an academic orientation program which helps students decide their future study plans. Students are encouraged to create a curriculum that reflects their interests during the academic orientation program.

What are the entry requirements?

HAVO/VWO diploma, MBO (EPI) diploma niveau 4, International School of Aruba diploma or the Ibero American High School diploma.

Please note that candidates who have left their secondary education for more than one year will not be eligible for participation.



What can I do with a certificate of AFY?

At the end of the AFY, students will have a strong academic foundation, and be prepared for whatever area of concentration they decide to pursue. You'll have a better sense of what you want and have the academic skills to excel in whatever area of study you choose.




General Campus Information
